

# PCQG Mystery Quilt 2021

There is a message in this needlework.  
Can you solve the mystery name of your finished quilt?

First, find your 3 suspect fabrics. You will need: 1) a feature fabric; 2) a coordinate fabric; and 3) a contrast fabric.

All of your first cuts should be done with the fabric folded selvage-to-selvage. Be sure to remove all selvage edges before making the first cuts.

| Middle border: Contrast                       | 3/8 yd.   | 7 strips 1 1/2" x 40"                   |
| Outer border: Feature                         | 1 yd.     | 7 strips 4 1/2" x 40"                   |
| Cornerstones: Contrast                        | scraps    | 4 squares 3 1/2" x 3 1/2"               |
| Binding                                       | 2/3 yd.   | Add to contrast yds.                    |
| Backing                                       | 4 3/4 yd. |   |
